To ensure a smooth transition between all elements of your special day, we would recommend the following schedule:

2.30 PM	Supplier access to the Turbine room for decorating
4.30 PM	Guests arrive
5 PM	Ceremony in the Turbine room
5.30 PM	Photographs around the reserve
6 PM	Drinks reception on the Mezzanine
7.30 PM	Dinner in the Triple Engine Room
9.30 PM	Dancing in the Boiler Room
11.00 PM	Bar closed
11.30 PM	Last song
MIDNIGHT	All guests departed

For early closure, we would recommend adjusting the above schedule by 1 hour and a half.

Please note the visitor centre closes at 4pm in the winter (Oct-Mar) and 5pm in the summer (Apr-Sep). We can close the visitor centre up to 1 hour earlier for an additional fee.

For couples hosting ceremony and reception onsite, set up may begin in the Turbine Room up to two hours before the guest arrival time stated to the left.

Suppliers will have access to the remaining areas of the Engine House once the building is closed to the public.

Wedding & civil ceremonies

If you wish to hold a legal wedding or civil ceremony with us, the process is as follows:

1.

Provisionally confirm a ceremony date & time with one of our event planners

2.

Give notice of the marriage to the borough in which you are resident

3.

Book your registrar directly with Waltham Forest Council

VISITOR CENTRE

The visitor centre, café and nature reserve are open to the general public 7 days a week, from 9:30am until 4pm (Oct-Mar) and 5pm (Apr-Sep) and toilet facilities are shared with event guests during these times.

FURNITURE

There are 70 white & black conference chairs available for use, as well the café furniture. If you wish to hire in alternative furniture for an additional cost, please speak to your Event Planner for options.

WETLANDS RESERVE

Your guests are welcome to explore the nature reserve before or immediately after your ceremony, however once your drinks reception commences or the reserve closes to the public (whichever is first) for security reasons there will be no further access to the reserve for any guests.

MUSIC

There is no built-in PA system, so any music will need to be provided by external suppliers. We allow live bands and DJs but ask that they kindly adhere to the sound limit policy, which is 85 decibels. The Event Manager will monitor levels on the night.

SECURITY

For evening events and when serving alcohol, we are required by our license to have two members of security present. This cost is included in the venue hire.

FAQs

OUR MOST ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What decorations can I bring?

You can decorate the interior areas with flowers, candles (in holders) & free standing props. For environmental reasons we do not allow balloons, fireworks or glitter.

3. Can I leave items overnight following the event?

The venue is extremely limited on storage space and is in frequent use so all items will need to be taken off site by the end of the hire time.

5. Can I use a Celebrant for my ceremony?

Absolutely! A celebrant is a non-legal person who can conduct your ceremony in a more personal way. They cannot legally marry you, but a great alternative to a registrar if you are planning to legally marry on a different day.

2. Can my guests use confetti?

Guests may use dried flower petals only but we request this is only thrown outside the building.

4. Is there parking?

Yes, there is large car park available on site. Guests leaving before 17:00 will need to pay for their parking and evening guests can park onsite for free. Please note, overnight parking charges apply.
