



About us

London Wildlife Trust champions nature's recovery in London. As a grassroots movement, we are firmly embedded in London's local communities, where we look after wild places and increase people's understanding of and connection to the natural world. We engage, inspire, and enable people to connect with nature and are resolute in our ambition to reverse the declines in nature.

The site was once a coal drop for the nearby station, which was demolished in the 1960s. It had been colonised by nature, so the Trust ran a campaign to save the site from development and create a nature reserve, which opened in 1985.

The contemporary Visitor Centre has multiple sustainable features, including a natural cooling and ventilation system and rainwater run-offs. The woodland, grassland, and wetland habitats provide a rich space for birds, butterflies, amphibians, and plant life to nest and grow in the city.

The profits raised from events and venue hire directly support our vital work towards a London alive with wildlife, nature in everyone's neighbourhood.



Events

Sitting on the banks of the Regents Canal, this two-acre wildlife haven is our most central venue. With King's Cross and St. Pancras on our doorstep, this location makes it a perfect venue for wildlife lovers looking for a convenient city destination.

Camley Street Natural Park offers a range of unique spaces to suit any event or occasion.

Daytime events

The Kingfisher Suite can be divided to create two individual spaces. It is a well-equipped space with natural scenery for your next meeting or daytime celebration.

Plaque and Education Room

- Venue Spaces

The main Kingfisher Suite can be split into two adjoining rooms with a sound-proof wall divider for smaller daytime meetings.

Equipped with a projector and screen as well as tables and chairs, you just simply need to arrive on your meeting day.

Pay-as-you-go

Bar set-up charges

Up to 50 guests: £300+VAT

• 51-100 guests: £400+VAT

101-150 guests: £550+VAT

These fees apply if you are opting for a pay-as-you-go or prepaid bar service and must be paid in advance. This fee does not include any drinks.

Facilities

Audio visual

Each room is equipped with a projector and screen, as well as a speaker system for videos and presentations. A HDMI-enabled laptop is required for use. For additional AV requirements, please consult our approved supplier list.

Furniture

There are 80 wooden folding chairs and 10 simple wooden trestle tables available for use, as well as café seating for evening events. If additional furniture is required or you require exact measurements, please discuss with your Event Planner.

Café and visitor centre

Please note the reserve is open to the general public seven days a week from 10am-4pm (October-March) 10am-5pm (April-September), and the toilet facilities are shared.

Security

For evening events and events serving alcohol, we are required by our license to have a member of security staff. This cost is included in the venue hire.





FAQs

What decorations can I bring?

You can decorate the interior areas with flowers, candles (in holders), and free-standing props. For environmental reasons, we do not allow balloons, fireworks, or glitter.

Is there parking?

No, there is no parking available on site. There is a small entranceway for deliveries to be dropped off, but all vehicles must be kept offsite.

Can I leave items overnight following the event?

The venue is extremely limited in storage space and is in frequent use so all items must be taken off-site by the end of the hire time.

Can I use my own suppliers?

Due to our unique space, we only allow suppliers from our approved list who have been through the assessment process. For any event requirements not currently covered by the list, please speak to your Event Planner directly.

Can my guests go in the nature reserve?

Guests are welcome to walk freely around the nature reserve in daylight hours, but glass is strictly prohibited and so we would restrict access once the bar is open during evening events. During the winter (October-March) access to the nature reserve in the evening will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
