London Wildlife Trust champions nature's recovery in London. In 1894, the Engine House pumping station and surrounding reservoirs at Walthamstow Wetlands were built to provide London's population with safe and reliable drinking water.

Europe's largest urban wetland nature reserve is now a vital sanctuary to several bird species. In addition to being operationally significant, the Wetlands continue to provide drinking water to over 3 million people in London.

Venue Spaces

Turbine Room

Filled with light bouncing off the tiled walls, the sunbathed room displays subtle hints of character with some original features and machinery still on display.

It can be hired during the week for meetings and team away days or transformed in the evening and weekends for drinks receptions, birthday parties, anniversary celebrations and dinners.

Mezzanine

The Mezzanine is host to a rolling art exhibition, and the balcony offers

spectacular views over the south reservoirs and the London skyline.

The industrial heritage features and contemporary brick facade make it the perfect location for a drinks reception. This space can be hired as a semi-private space during the day or as part of the whole venue in the evening.

Triple Engine Room

Make a spectacular impact with a seated dinner or standing reception in the Triple Engine Room, framed by the heritage wooden panelling and coloured glazing.

For larger numbers, guest seating can extend out on to the external terrace.

Boiler Room

This open plan area is a blank canvas for evening events with large arched windows and a raised platform, making it a versatile space for conferences, receptions, dinners and dancing.

Pay-as-you-go

A pre-agreed bar tab is open for guests to choose their drinks.

Bar set-up charges

Up to 50 guests: £300+VAT

• 51-100 guests: £400+VAT

101-150 guests: £550+VAT

These fees apply if you are opting for a pay-as-you-go or prepaid bar service and must be paid in advance. This fee does not include any drinks.

More Information

Visitor Centre

The visitor centre, café and nature reserve are open to the general public 7 days a week, from 9:30am until 4pm (winter) and 5pm (summer) and the toilet facilities are shared with event guests during these times.

Furniture

There are 80 white & black conference chairs available for use, as well the café furniture. If you wish to hire in alternative furniture for an additional cost, please speak to your event planner for options.

Wetlands Reserve

For daytime events, your guests are welcome to explore the nature reserve during public opening hours. For security reasons there will be no further access after this time.

Music

There is no built-in PA system, so any music will need to be provided by external suppliers. We allow live bands and DJs but ask that they kindly adhere to the sound limit policy, which is 90 decibels. The event manager will monitor levels on the night.

Security

For evening events and events serving alcohol, we are required by our license to have a member of security staff. This cost is included in the venue hire.



FAQs

What decorations can I bring?

You can decorate the interior areas with flowers, candles (in holders), and free-standing props. For environmental reasons, we do not allow balloons, fireworks, or glitter.

Is there parking?

No, there is no parking available on site. There is a small entranceway for deliveries to be dropped off, but all vehicles must be kept offsite.

Can I leave items overnight following the event?

The venue is extremely limited in storage space and is in frequent use so all items must be taken off-site by the end of the hire time.

Can I use my own suppliers?

Due to our unique space, we only allow suppliers from our approved list who have been through the assessment process. For any event requirements not currently covered by the list, please speak to your Event Planner directly.

Can my guests go in the nature reserve?

Guests are welcome to walk freely around the nature reserve in daylight hours, but glass is strictly prohibited and so we would restrict access once the bar is open during evening events. During the winter (October-March) access to the nature reserve in the evening will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
