London Wildlife Trust champions nature's recovery in London. As a grassroots movement, we are firmly embedded in London's local communities, where we look after wild places and increase people's understanding of and connection to the natural world. We engage, inspire, and enable people to connect with nature and are resolute in our ambition to reverse the declines in nature.

A working reservoir near Manor House, closed to the public for 200 years, is now a beautiful nature reserve. It's a thriving habitat for migratory birds. Hedgerows and wildflowers line the banks of the reservoir, while the reedbed provides a wetland haven for waterfowl.

The profits raised from events and venue hire directly support our vital work towards a London alive with wildlife, nature in everyone's neighbourhood.



The Canopy

- Venue Spaces

A wildlife haven of reedbed and shimmering waves, juxtaposed with a cityscape, offers a unique and magical backdrop for your celebration.

The canopy is the perfect setting to host events such as drinks, receptions, birthday parties, anniversary celebrations, and dinners.

The Coal House and Roof Terrace

- Venue Spaces

The Grade II listed building is the perfect venue to dance the night away with your guests.

The space can also be hired for intimate dinners of up to 30 guests.

You will also have exclusive access to the roof terrace (max capacity 20) to take in the panoramic views of the reservoirs. Here you can enjoy a private drink or take photographs in front of the incredible backdrop.

Pay-as-you-go

Guests purchase their own drinks.

Pre-paid tab

A pre-agreed bar tab is open for guests to choose their drinks.

Bar set-up charges

Up to 50 guests: £300+VAT

• 51-100 guests: £400+VAT

101-150 guests: £550+VAT

These fees apply if you are opting for a pay-as-you-go or prepaid bar service and must be paid in advance. This fee does not include any drinks.

If you require a more premium service, such as tray service, please enquire with your Event Planner for a quote.



Facilities

Coal House Café

Please note the reserve is open to the general public seven days a week from 9am-4pm (October-March), 9am-4.30pm (April-September), and the toilet facilities are shared.

Furniture

As part of the venue hire fee, you are welcome to use the café furniture for informal seating. If you wish to hire in alternative furniture for an additional cost, please speak to your Event Planner.

Toilets

There are two toilet cubicles at the Coal House. If guest numbers go above 80, you will need to hire additional facilities. Please speak to your Event Planner for more details and costs.

Music

There is no built-in PA system, and music will need to be provided by our approved suppliers. We do not allow live bands but do allow DJ's inside the Coal House. We kindly ask that they adhere to the sound limit policy, which is 85 decibels. Only acoustic background music is allowed outside, and no speakers must be used outside the Coal House. The event manager will monitor levels on the night.

Wetlands Reserve

Due to safety reasons for evening events, we can only permit guest access on the west side of the reservoir between the Boardwalk and Coal House.

Security

For evening events and events serving alcohol, we are required by our license to have a member of security staff. This cost is included in the venue hire.







FAQs

What decorations can I bring?

You can decorate the interior areas with flowers, candles (in holders), and free-standing props. For environmental reasons, we do not allow balloons, fireworks, or glitter.

Is there parking?


No, there is no parking available on site. There is a small entranceway for deliveries to be dropped off, but all vehicles must be kept offsite.

Can I leave items overnight following the event?

The venue is extremely limited in storage space and is in frequent use so all items must be taken off-site by the end of the hire time.

Can I use my own suppliers?

Due to our unique space, we only allow suppliers from our approved list who have been through the assessment process. For any event requirements not currently covered by the list, please speak to your Event Planner directly.
