London Wildlife Trust is therefore fully committed to the care of the environment, prevention of pollution and to continually improve its environmental performance. London Wildlife Trust has therefore implemented a documented Environmental Management System.

London Wildlife Trust ensures that all their activities are carried out in compliance with the relevant environmental legislation and other requirements and meets, or where possible, exceeds the requirements of BS 8555:2003 Stage 3.


The following key activities have been identified as significant:

- **Biodiversity** – London Wildlife Trust is committed to increasing the understanding for biodiversity conservation as well as minimising our own impacts on biodiversity
- **Energy** – London Wildlife Trust is committed to minimising their consumption of non-renewable energy sources and to continually research alternative sources and technology to reduce consumption of energy across all activities
- **Waste** – London Wildlife Trust is committed to minimising the waste it generates and the associated impacts by seeking opportunities to reduce, reuse, recycle and recover otherwise redundant resources
- **Transport** – London Wildlife Trust is aware of the environmental impacts of their transport operations, and seeks ways to reduce them wherever practical through the use of journey planning, sustainable transport and IT solutions
- **Procurement** – London Wildlife Trust works to ensure that the products, services and materials which it purchases are as sustainable as practical

London Wildlife Trust has introduced systems that will set, achieve and review measurable environmental objectives. The Chief Executive will provide appropriate resources as required in order to enable the company to meet these objectives.

All staff are made aware of the aims and objectives of the Environmental Management System and associated Operating Procedures and are expected to adhere to their requirements.
